

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING REGARDING DEVELOPMENT CHARGES

Take notice that on Monday May 10th 2021 the Council of the Municipality of Kincardine will hold a public meeting regarding proposed development charge rates and policies that will be applied throughout the Municipality. It is proposed that enactment of a development charges by-law by Council would occur on a date subsequent to this public meeting.

Development charges are levied against new development, and are a primary source of funding for growth-related capital expenditures. The 2021 Development Charges Background Study relates to the provision of the following eligible DC Services: Parks and Recreation, Services Related to a Highway: Public Works & Municipal Fleet, Fire Protection, Waste Management, Development Related Studies, Services Related to a Highway: Roads and Related, Water and Wastewater.

All interested parties are invited to attend the public meeting. Further to the COVID-19 Pandemic this meeting will be held electronically in accordance with Section 238 of the Municipal Act, 1990 which provides for Electronic Participation where an emergency has been declared to exist in all or part of the municipality under Section 4 or 7.01 of the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act.

Any person may attend the public meeting and make written or verbal representation either in support of or in opposition to the by-law.
