BRUCE AVENUE – ROAD RECONSTRUCTION AND CULVERT REPLACEMENT BRUCE AVENUE FROM PRINCES STREET SOUTH TO KINCARDINE WWTP

PROJECT NO. 17318

Introduction

The Municipality of Kincardine is proceeding with a municipal infrastructure project to replace an existing sanitary force main that extends from the Huron Terrace Sewage Pumping Station (SPS) to the Kincardine Wastewater Treatment Plant on Bruce Avenue. As part of the project, affected road sections will be reconstructed and the culvert spanning the Stewart Drain on Bruce Avenue, will be replaced. The project is being completed in phases, with the section along Bruce Avenue being undertaken during the summer and fall of 2020. Access to the affected section of Bruce Avenue will be limited to local traffic only during the project, with access to the portion of Bruce Avenue where the culvert is located (immediately west of the soccer fields), completely closed for the duration of the culvert replacement. Access to the soccer fields and Legion Trail will be maintained however there will be times where access may be restricted.

The project is being administered by engineering staff from B. M. Ross and Associates Limited, Project Engineers retained by the Municipality of Kincardine to design the proposed infrastructure replacement project. The infrastructure and road construction is being completed by Birnam Excavating Ltd who has been selected through the tendering process.

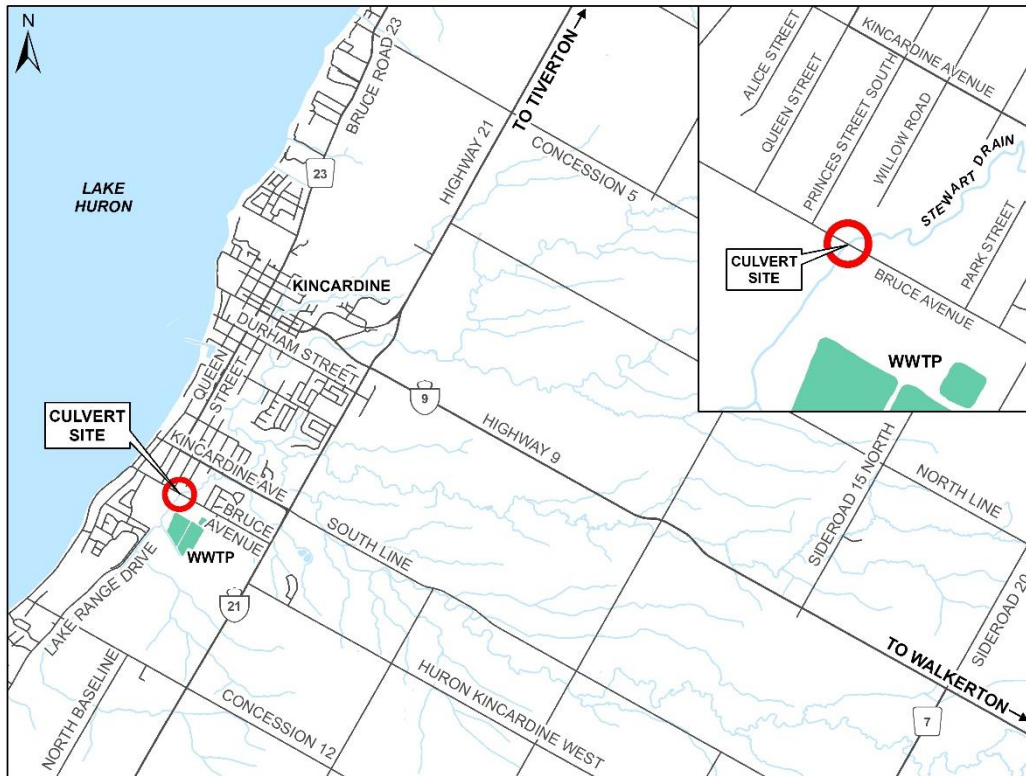

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Project Details

The work is to generally include the following

- Replacement of an existing sanitary force main and installation of new stormwater drainage infrastructure along Bruce Avenue from Princes Street South to the Kincardine Wastewater Treatment Plant.
- Replacement of the existing culvert spanning the Stewart Drain immediately west of the soccer fields.
- Full road reconstruction including the installation of curb and gutter and a sidewalk adjacent to the south boulevard.

The following figure shows the location of Bruce Avenue and the culvert replacement site.



Construction Schedule

- The project is scheduled to start in mid-July 2020 subject to weather.
- Work along Bruce Avenue is anticipated to be completed by November of 2020.

Utilities

- An existing Rogers pole line located on the south side of Bruce Avenue will be removed and replaced with buried conduit along the south boulevard. Temporary disruptions to this and other utilities may occur during the course of the construction project, however prior notification will be provided to residents.

Traffic Control

- Access to the affected section of Bruce Avenue will be closed to all but local traffic for the duration of the project. Bruce Avenue at the culvert replacement site will be closed to all traffic during that component of the work.
- Detour signage will be provided to assist in directing traffic.
- Emergency Services will be made aware of the works and the contractor and Municipality will notify them when specific locations are under construction.

Covid-19

- Due to potential concerns related to Covid-19, members of the public are asked to respect social distancing guidelines when in the vicinity of the work site.
