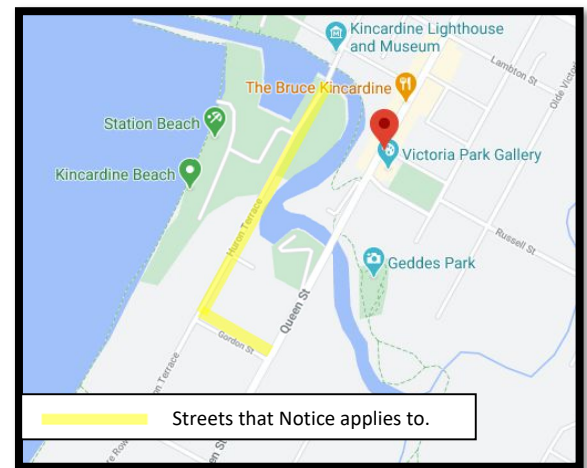
## HURON TERRACE FORCEMAIN INSTALLATION (GORDON ST. TO PUMPING STATION) GORDON STREET FORCEMAIN INSTALLATION

### Introduction

In February you were provided with a public notice which detailed the work to be completed in 2021 as part of the municipal infrastructure project to replace an existing sanitary forcemain that extends from the Huron Terrace Sewage Pumping Station (SPS) to the Kincardine Wastewater Treatment Plant on Bruce Avenue. In that notice the streets impacted by the planned construction were highlighted and details related to the approximate schedule and extent of work were provided.

**You should refer to the earlier notice for specific details related to contacts, garbage collection, extent of work, etc.**

The purpose of this notice is to provide an update as it relates to schedule and road closures for work on Huron Terrace and Gordon Street. The following is noted related to specifics for each location:



### Gordon Street

Starting on April 19<sup>th</sup>, Birnam will mobilize to Gordon Street. The road will be closed to through traffic but will remain open to local traffic during the period of construction. It is anticipated that the removal of asphalt (between the curbing) and installation of the new forcemain will be completed within the first week but could possibly extend into the week of April 26<sup>th</sup>.

### Huron Terrace

Following the completion of work on Gordon Street and during the week of April 26<sup>th</sup>, Birnam will mobilize to Huron Terrace to complete the installation of the forcemain under the east boulevard of the road between the pumping station site and Gordon Street. Some disturbance to the east boulevard area, sidewalk, driveways, and part of the east asphalt driving surface will occur and will be repaired as part of the construction activities. The road will be closed to through traffic but will remain open to local traffic only for the duration of the work on Huron Terrace. Detours will be in place accordingly. It is anticipated that the detour on Huron Terrace will remain in place until approximately mid-May.

### General

During construction there may be times when access to the driveways may be restricted but will be made passable by the end of each work day. When the underground work is completed and where the road surface has been impacted the road will be restored to gravel grade and will remain that way until the base asphalt is placed in late spring or early summer. Driveways will be ramped with granular during that period to allow full driveway access.
