CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

HURON TERRACE FORCEMAIN INSTALLATION (KINCARDINE AVE.) KINCARDINE AVENUE – PRINCES STREET TO QUEEN STREET

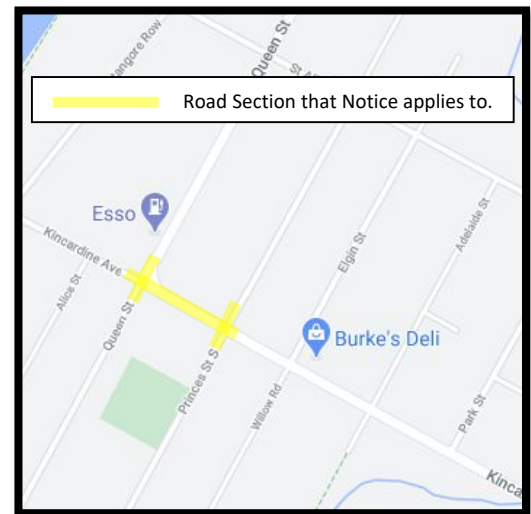
Introduction

In February you may have been provided with a public notice which detailed the work to be completed in 2021 as part of the municipal infrastructure project to replace an existing sanitary forcemain that extends from the Huron Terrace Sewage Pumping Station (SPS) to the Kincardine Wastewater Treatment Plant on Bruce Avenue. In that notice the streets impacted by the planned construction were highlighted and details related to the approximate schedule and extent of work were provided.

The purpose of this notice is to provide an update as it relates to schedule and road closures for work on **Kincardine Ave between Princes St and Queen St**. The following specifics relate to construction at this location:

Kincardine Avenue

Starting on June 14th, Birnam will mobilize to Kincardine Ave to complete the installation of the new forcemain and other infrastructure between the west side of the intersection of Queen St/Kincardine St and the east side of the intersection of Princes St/Kincardine Ave.



It is anticipated that the underground work will be completed by the end of June. Restoration of the roadway will be completed during the first two weeks of July.

On the first day of construction, the intersection of Queen St/Kincardine Ave will be closed to traffic entirely. For the remainder of the work this section of Kincardine Ave will be closed to through traffic but will remain open to local traffic. Due to the nature of construction, there may also be various times when intermittent closures may be necessary without warning, but efforts will be made to minimize these occurrences.

General

Signage will be installed noting that businesses on Queen St will be accessible as will those with entrances directly off Kincardine Ave. For information purposes the proposed traffic control plan is attached.
