BY-LAW

NO. 2025 - 124

Being a By-law to Establish 2026 Rates and Fees for Services Performed by the Municipality of Kincardine

Whereas Section 391 (1) of the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, authorizes municipalities to pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on persons,

- (a) for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it;
- (b) for costs payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or any local board; and
- (c) for the use of its property including property under its control.

Whereas Municipal Councils have the authority to establish rates and fees under various acts; now therefore be it

Resolved that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Kincardine **Enacts** as follows:

- 1. That the Council of the Municipality of Kincardine hereby establishes the rates and fees for services described in Schedules A to O attached hereto and forming part of this By-law.
- 2. That all other By-laws inconsistent with this By-law, are hereby repealed.
- 3. That this By-law shall come into full force and effect January 1st, 2026.
- 4. That this By-law may be cited as the "2026 Rates and Fees By-law".
