Resolved that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Kincardine **Enacts** as follows:

- That the Council of the Municipality of Kincardine hereby establishes the rates and fees for services described in Schedules A to O attached hereto and forming part of this By-law.
- 2. That all other By-laws inconsistent with this By-law, are hereby repealed.
- 3. That this By-law shall come into full force and effect January 1st, 2026.
- 4. That this By-law may be cited as the "2026 Rates and Fees By-law".

Whereas the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Kincardine passed By-law 2025 – 124 on the 24th day of September, 2025 to establish rates and fees for services performed by the Municipality of Kincardine; and Council deems it necessary to amend Schedule C to align with the Zoning By-law, update payment in lieu of parking rates, updates to the Consent fee and joint applications, and for the removal of the Consent application deposit; and Schedule K to reflect revisions made to Development Charges fees, in accordance with the most recent twelve month change in the Statistics Canada Quarterly, Construction Price Statistics, as per the Development Charges By-law 2021-114; now therefore be it

Resolved that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Kincardine **Enacts** as follows:

- That Schedule C of the Municipality of Kincardine 2025 Rates and Fees By-law No. 2025 - 124, is hereby amended with the additional fees as outlined on the attached Schedule 'A'
- That Schedule K of the Municipality of Kincardine 2025 Rates and Fees By-law No. 2025 - 124, is hereby amended with the additional fees as outlined on the attached Schedule 'B'
- 3. That this By-law shall come into full force and effect January 1st, 2026.
- 4. That this By-law may be cited as the "2026 Rates and Fee Amendment (1) By-law".
