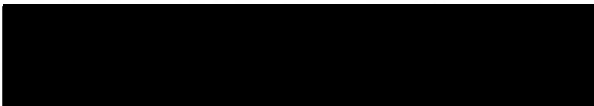
Direction to Staff to Prepare the 2027 Budget

In accordance with section 284.16 of the Municipal Act, and section 7 of Ontario Regulation 530/22, the Mayor shall, on or before February 1 of each year, prepare a proposed budget for the Municipality, provide the proposed budget to Council for its consideration, and make the proposed budget available to the public.

I, Kenneth Craig, Mayor of the Municipality of Kincardine, pursuant to Section 284.3 of the Municipal Act, hereby direct the Chief Administrative Officer and the Director of Corporate Services/Treasurer as follows:

1. The Mayoral Direction MDI – 2026 – 01 be rescinded; and
2. Prepare the budget in accordance with past practices, including consultations with council, staff, and the public; and
3. Prepare the budget keeping in mind themes recommended by the mayor and council, including financial sustainability, sustainable growth and development, community vibrancy, and the natural environment; and
4. Include in the budget the equivalent of a 3% tax rate increase for the annual Asset Management funding requirement; and
5. Limit the total tax levy increase to a maximum of 5%, inclusive of the Asset Management funding; and
6. Present the draft 2027 budget to the Mayor no later than the end of day on December 11th, 2026, for distribution by the Mayor to Council prior to the end of day January 4, 2027, and subsequently present the draft at a Special Budget Amendment Meeting scheduled for January 18, 2027.

This direction is issued for the purpose of administrative continuity and timely budget preparation and shall be subject to review, amendment, or replacement by the incoming Mayor following the 2026 Municipal Election.
